Charge Policy

We will always offer a meal to all students regardless of their lunch account balance.

If a child's lunch account balance is zero or below we will only offer that child a meal. They will not be allowed to purchase any ala carte items. We will allow them to charge on their lunch account up to **three** hot lunches, which will create a negative balance on their account. If the student/parent still does not deposit money into their child's lunch account we will only offer that student a cheese sandwich meal. The student will be charged full price for this meal. A cheese sandwich meal consists of: cold cheese sandwich, fruit and vegetable bar and milk. This child will continue to be offered this meal until his/her lunch account is brought back to at least zero.
