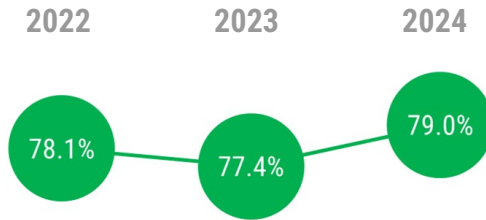

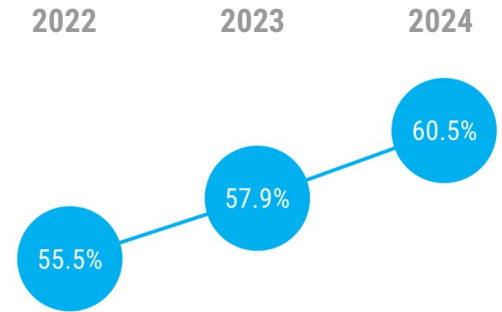

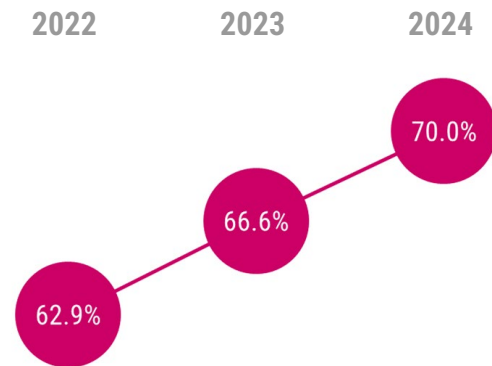

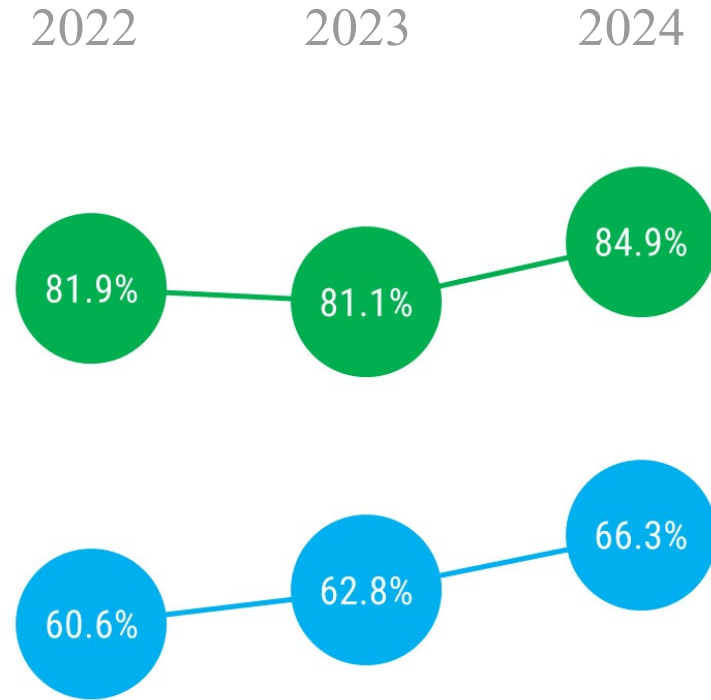

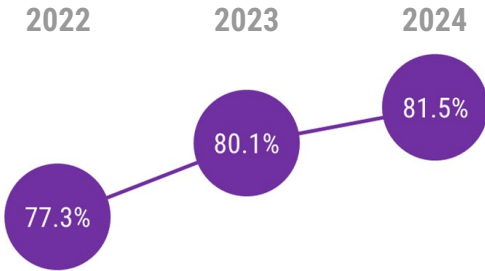
High school **students** are increasingly likely to know there are adults at school to whom they can reach out for support with **school** or **personal** problems



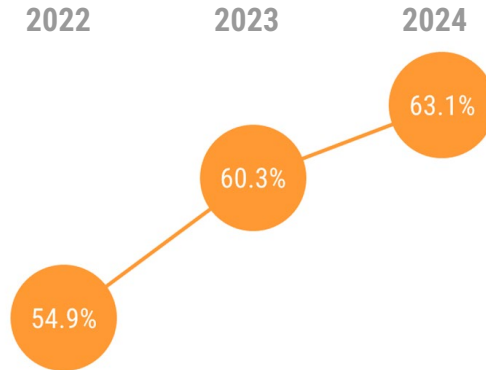

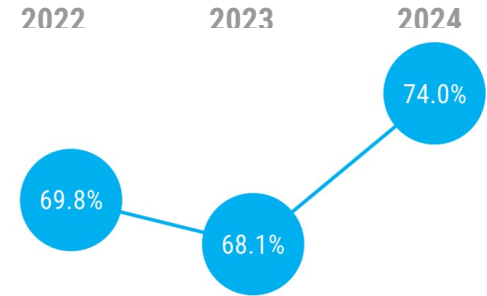

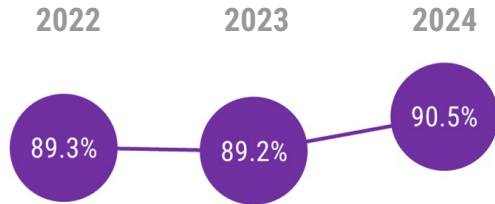

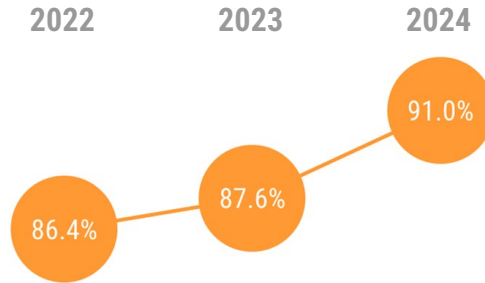

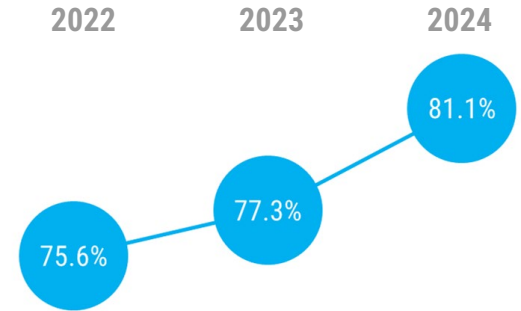

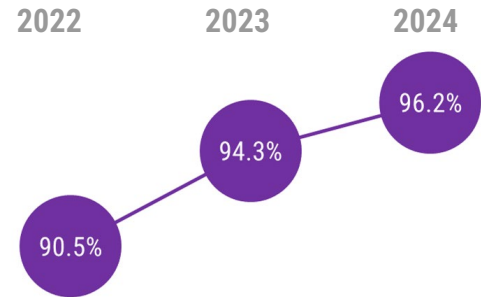

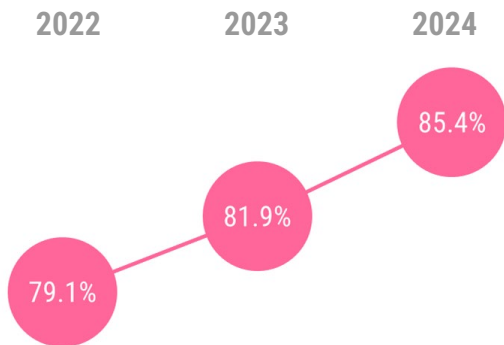

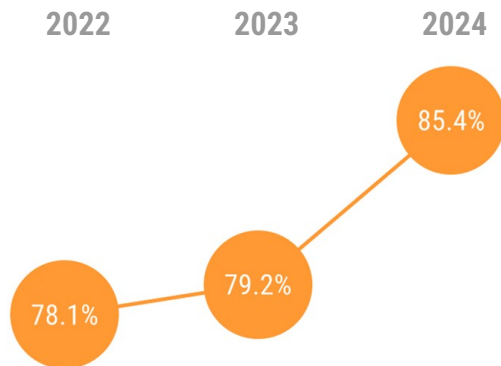

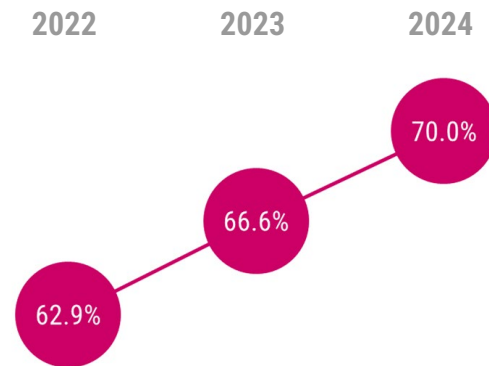

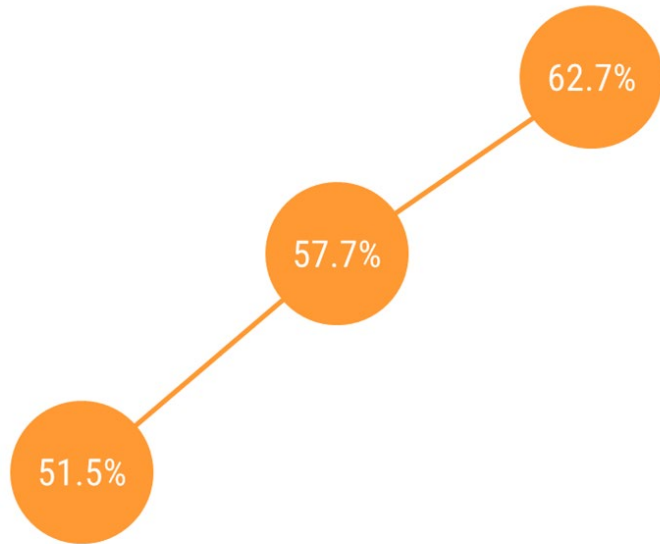
Increasing percentages of high school **students** feel...

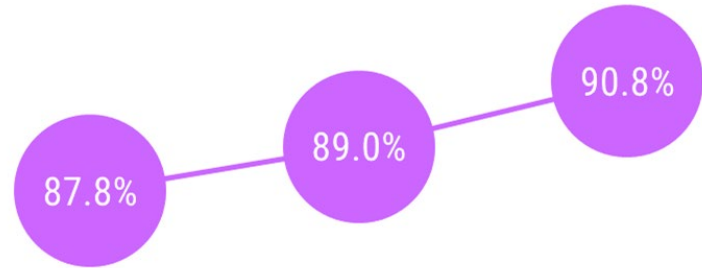

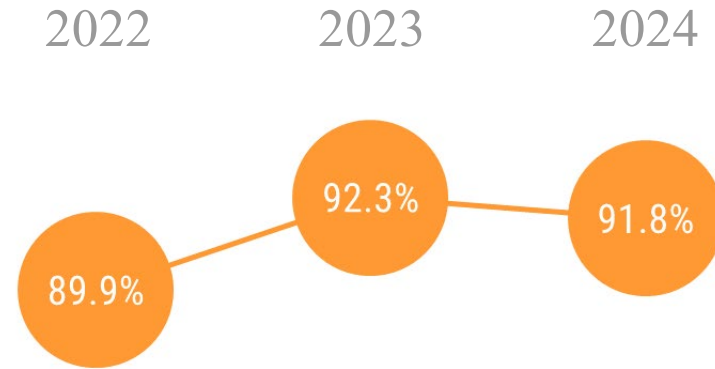

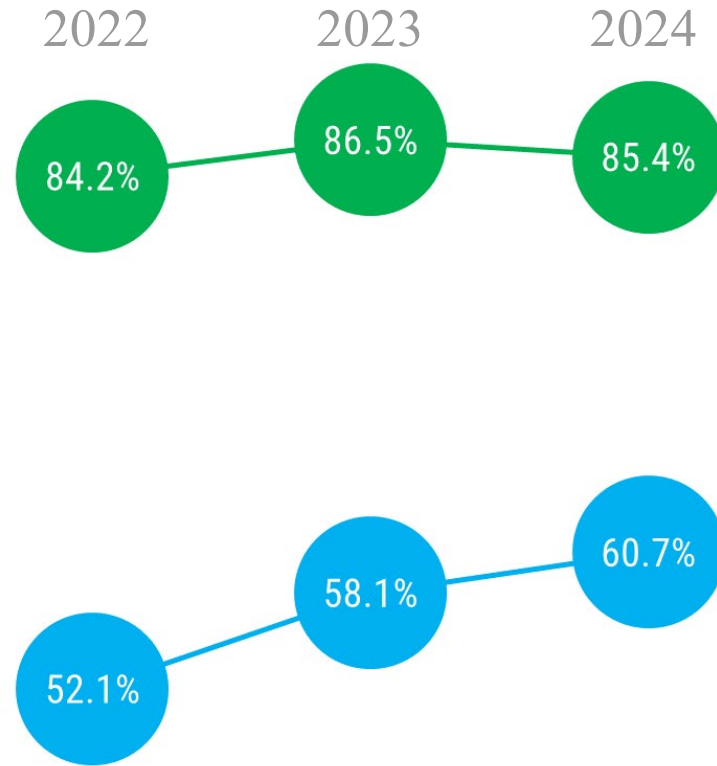


The vast majority of **families** continue to feel that teachers set **high expectations** for their children's learning



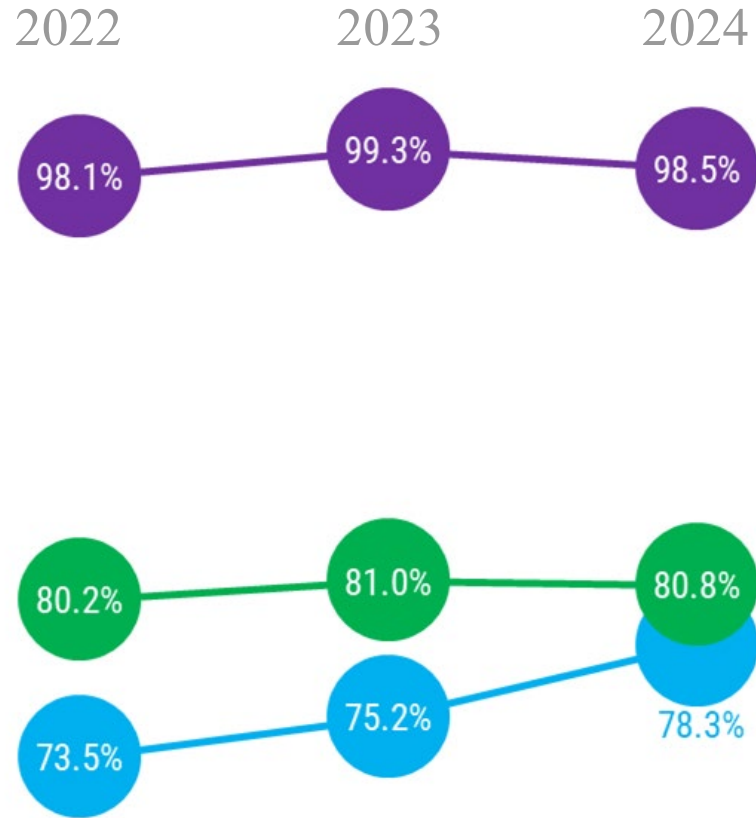


Although increasing, **students** remain less confident than their **families** that homework helps them learn





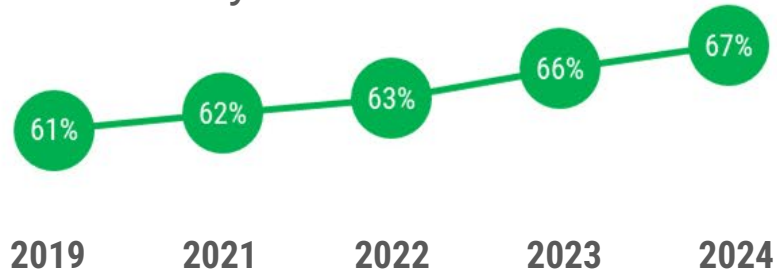
**Teachers** remain more confident than **students** and **families** that the feedback they give on assignments, quizzes, and tests helps students learn



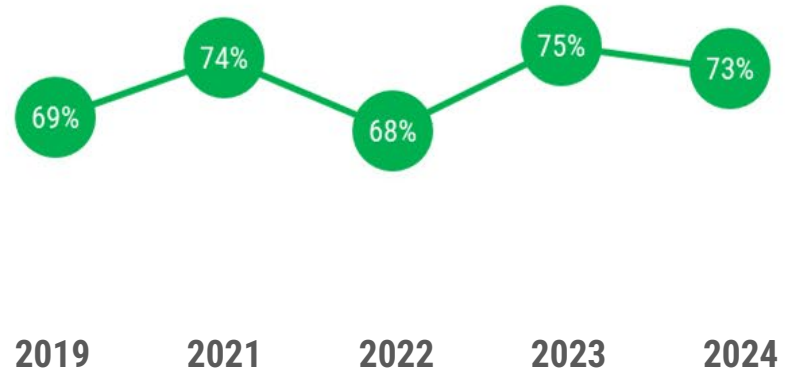

The **Percentage of Proficient** students on the 3rd Grade M-STEP English Language Arts continues to steadily increase

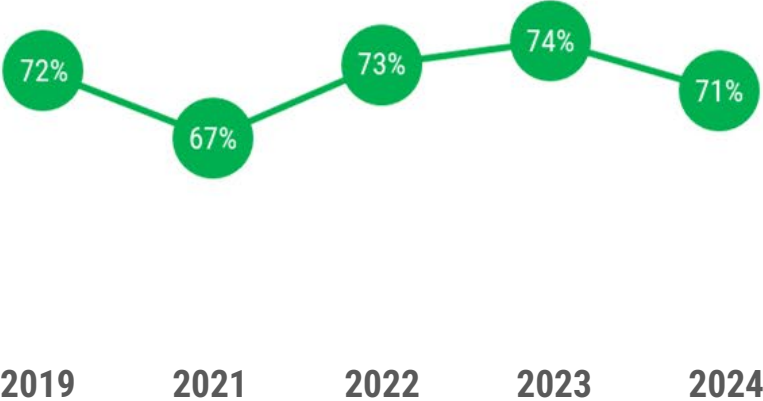


The percentage of proficient students on 3rd Grade M-STEP Math has also increased since 2019

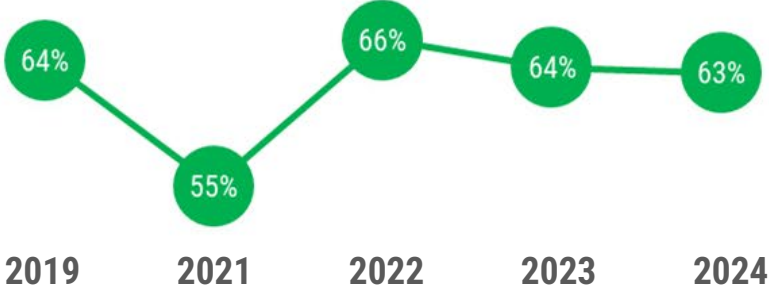




The **Percentage of Proficient** students on the 5th Grade M-STEP English Language Arts dipped slightly below pre-pandemic levels in 2024

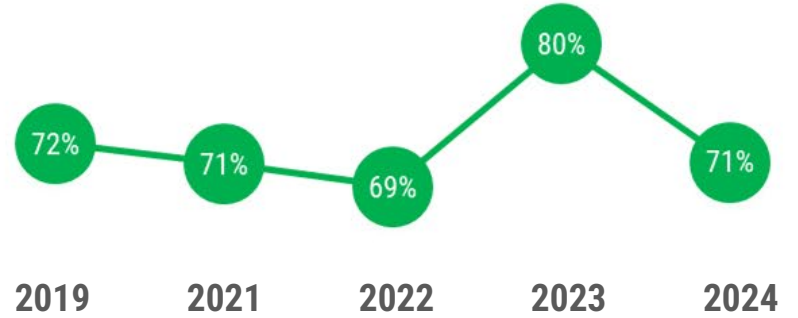

The **Percentage of Proficient** students on the 8th Grade PSAT Evidence-Based Reading remains high and continues to increase

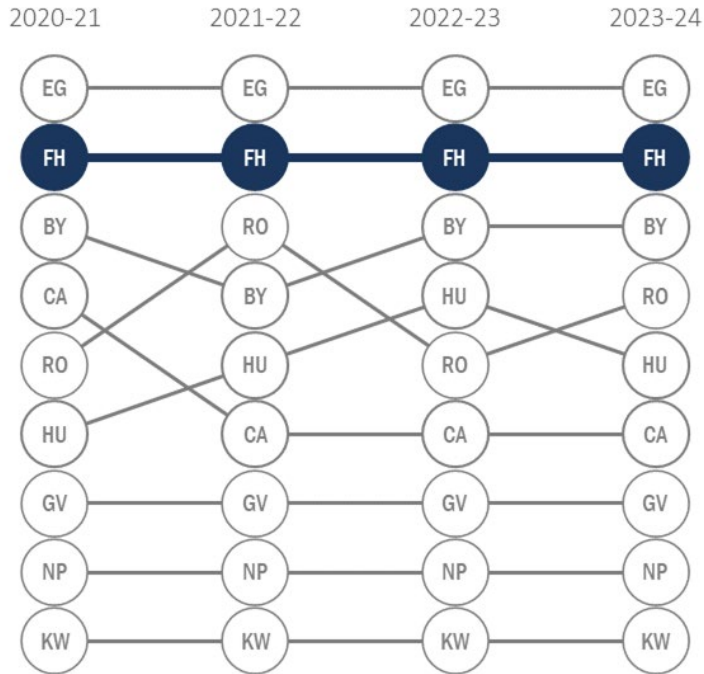


8th Grade PSAT Math bounced back substantially in 2023, but returned to approximate pre-pandemic levels in 2024

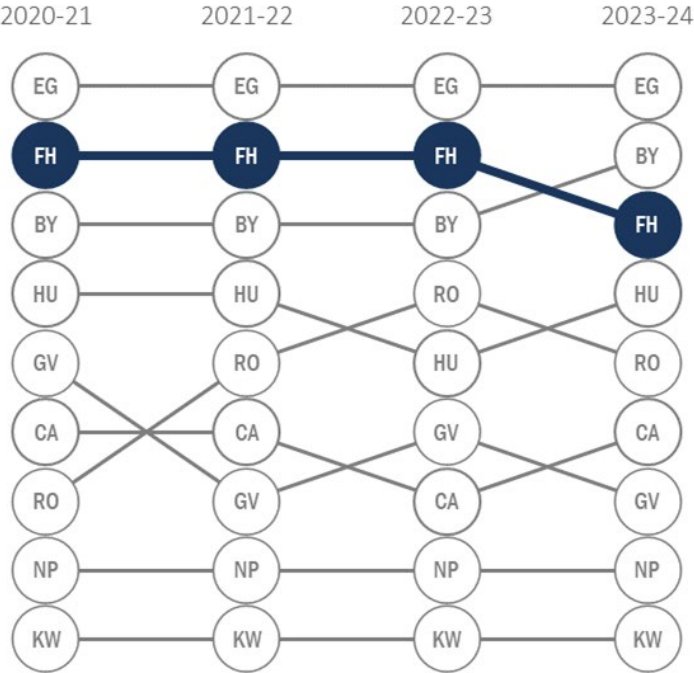

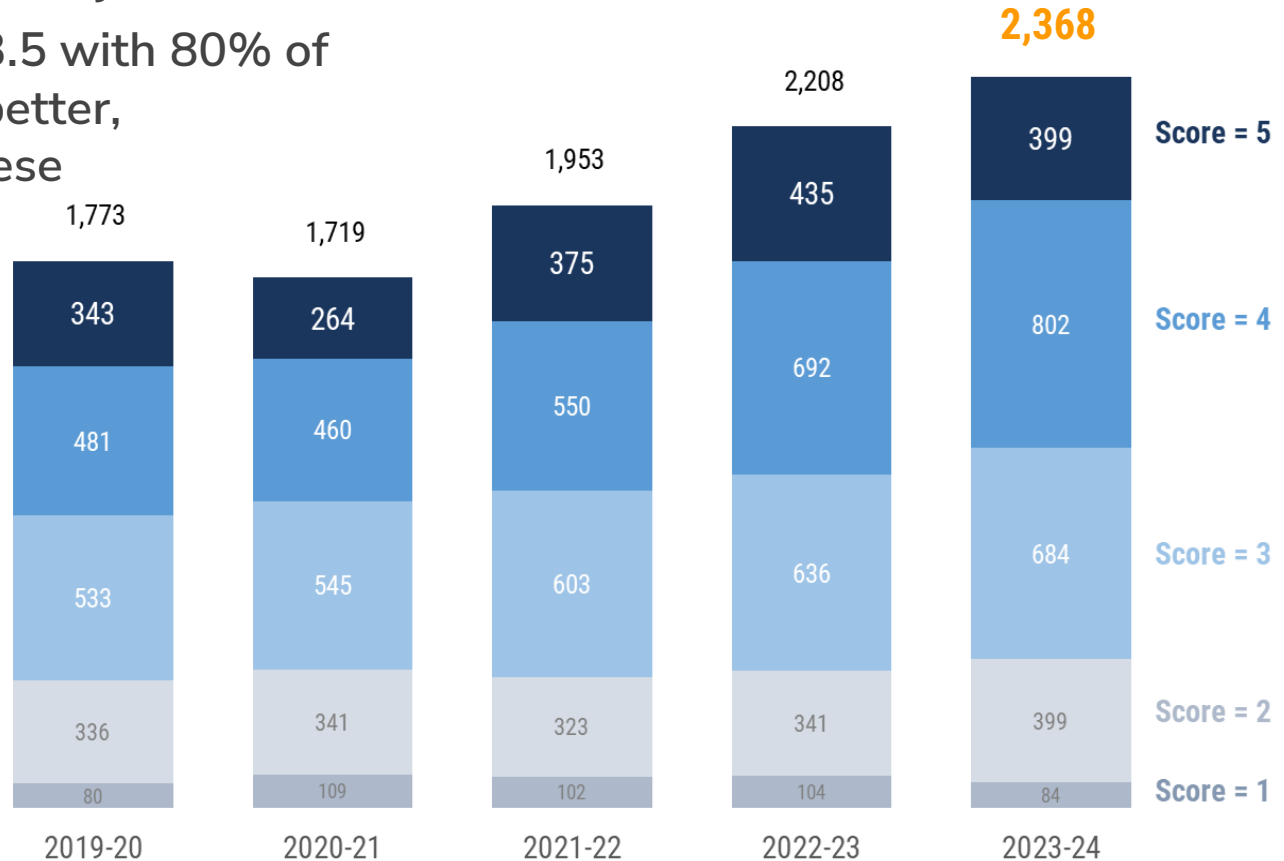
